AGC Member, Bob Shigemura - Had comments regarding incidents on the 200 yard range. Several months ago he was swept with a rifle and felt it was an unsafe condition. He feels much safer if there is an organized match going on because the Match Director is a Range Officer. All members need to always practice safe gun handling and be aware of other members before unloading, during shooting and when cleaning up.

AGC Member, Chuck Steinman - Found flattened shotgun slugs on the ground near the patterning board. Maybe a sign should be posted or pull the patterning board down and have the members shoot into the berms? After discussion it was decided to post a sign and if slugs are found again, the board will be pulled.

V. OLD BUSINESS

President, Mark Harper:

2007 Lead Recovery - Per Serena at Mihoda & Company, the following deposits were made: February was \$36,876.80, July was \$13,746.56, and September was \$27,551.33; totaling \$78,174.69.

Relocation Funds - In answer to Pete Benoit's question whether funds were specifically marked for "Relocation Fund". I have contacted all the banks involved and have asked that they go through their archives and see how these CD's were labeled when they were set up. Over the years many of these banks have changed ownership, making it more a slow process to research. So far our research shows that all 5 CD's have made money over the years, but we can find none that were specifically marked "Relocation Fund".

Rocky Mountain 3 Gun Incident on June 19,2010 - AGC member presented his side of the story on what happened at the match. He was very apologetic for his part in what took place during the match and not being able to attend a BOD meeting before now. Because the member involved stated that he was not renewing his membership, no disciplinary action will be taken. The members name will be noted for future reference.

We have had many requests from outside groups wanting the use of our range. After discussion on all aspects of the issue, the BOD decided against all outside groups using the range for firearms training.

Aurora Gun Club offers the opportunity for members with two years of membership or more to become a range officer (RO). As an RO you will be helping to keep the AGC running safely plus every hour worked will reduce your following year's dues by \$8.00. It is possible to work off all of the following year's dues by volunteering at the club! To become an RO one must attend an RO class, in so doing, the member becomes "certified" by the AGC as a Range Officer. This certification is by and for the AGC only and is not affiliated with the National Rifle Association however I do utilize NRA material in the class. I will hold one class Saturday January 15th at 1:00 PM in the classroom building, weather and schedule permitting.

If you plan to attend please contact me by email a day or so before the 15th to make sure the class will still be held.

Please note: if you were/are an RO, your certification is good for only 2 years. If you wish to continue to be an RO you must retake the class every 2 years! The AGC BOD set a mandate that from 2008 forward, ALL discipline chairmen/women (or their designated representative/s) must also attend an RO class every 2 years. Military Bolt Action Bench Rest

Octobers shoot was our annual Outlaw Sniper Match. This is our standard format with the one exception that scope, up to 4 power can be used. The match format is 5 ten shot strings at 100 yards; 2 tens for group, and 3 tens for score. Stock military bolt action rifles fired from the bench. Rules are posted on the club web site. We shoot the last Sunday of the month at 9 am sharp. Show up early to register and set up. There were four shooters in the scope class and three in the iron sight class. Small group was by Terry Humbarger in scope and Rob Lucernoni in iron sight in the first string and repeated in the second string. In score shooting (scope) it went: Terry tied with Rob Spurrier, followed by Paul Lundberg, and then Chuck Steinman, while iron sight went: Justin Lockhart, Rob L, and Jake Lockhart. In the second string it went: Rob S, Terry, and then Chuck, while in irons, it went: Rob L, Justin and Jake. In the final string scoped, it went: Rob S, Terry and Chuck. The iron sights went: Jake, Rob L, and Justin. Overall in scope, Rob S's 296-10x beat Terry's 294-12x followed by Chuck. In iron sights, Rob L's 270-2x beat Justin's 268-1x, followed buy Jake.
