AGC Member, Fugi Silva: When will the gate code be changed? 2nd VP Dave Bonner stated that the gate code will be changed February 1, 2012.

IV. ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT REPORT

Wait List - We are now at 317.

Membership Renewals - I have received and processed 562 Membership renewals.

V. BUSINESS

President, Mark Harper:

Construction - Construction has started. The 200 yard range will be closed while the construction is going on. We will have a range officer on duty to ensure safety.

Quarterly Report - We are in the process of working with the CPA. Full disclosure of the report at the January BOD meeting. The report will also be printed in the newsletter.

1st VP, Chuck Steinman:

New Member Orientation - I will be reviewing the new member paperwork and I will upgrade as necessary.

2nd VP, Dave Bonner:

Clubhouse Closed - The clubhouse will be closed Sunday, January 1st (New Year's Day). If you plan on using the range on that day you need to plan accordingly.

Work Party Dues - Last month I asked the BOD to consider increasing member compensation for working at the club from \$8.00 per hour to \$10.00 per hour. After discussion it was decided that maybe the increase in compensation may entice more members to work at the club.

2nd VP, Dave Bonner Continued:

Trap Meeting - We had a large turnout on Saturday, December 10th. There were quite a few ideas to increase the usage and income on the trap range. Starting in March a Progressive shoot pot will be implemented and a club trophy shoot will start the 4th Sunday. Flyers will be made up promoting trap at the AGC and left at sporting goods stores. Ted Forsythe, Loren Kohler and Alex Ragulsky will submit range dates and recommendations when they have put everything together. The trap shooter's agreed that when the temperatures are below 40 degrees, they will not shoot and the trap kids will not work. They also agreed to change the winter trap hours to 10am - 1pm. A Trap Chairman would be helpful in implementing the various ideas that the trap shooters have.

Chief Range Officer - The Chief Range Officer position has been filled by Pete Benoit. All Discipline Chairman are required to take this class and will be given 1st priority. Pete will be announcing the dates in January's newsletter.

Sable Altura Fire Inspection - The fire department came out and inspected the club. We need to purchase and install exit signs in the clubhouse. For the education trailer we need purchase and install fire extinguishers and smoke detectors. We also need to purchase a Knox Box and install it on our property by the gate that will enable the fire department to enter our property. The box will hold the combo to the gate along with keys to the clubhouse and the education trailer.

Work Parties for 2012 - I would like approval from the board to close the range on March 11, April 29, and May 13 to hold work parties.

Snow Removal - Our tractor does not plow the snow very well. I am going to look into the cost of a snow plow service to better clear the property of snow. Debra Caldwell worked in the snow removal business and knows that the cost will be high. Debra Caldwell suggested that we look into the cost of purchasing a used four wheel drive truck with a snow plow on it.

Member Rules - We went over the Member Rules. Following are the changes:

Add: Proper/appropriate
Now reads "Use of proper/appropriate steel targets on the 100 yard range, etc....."
30. "A shotgun patterning board is located in berm 1." **NEW ADDITION**
31. Remove the words "for the additional non family guest and"
Add: "Prior to setting up" the member is responsible for payment.
36. Removed
37. Removed
41. Old: All firing on 50 yard ranges will be forward of the markers on these ranges
New. All firing on ranges will be forward of the markers.
51. Remove the words "and the 17HMR"
Now reads: "Long range rimfire, center fire rifles, and long range hand guns are permitted on this range".

52. Remove: "except for position shooting."
Remove: "The range flag shall be used at all times. When the flag is up, the range is OPEN. When the range flag is down, the range is CLOSED".

- We added a new section titled "**PROHIBITED DEVICES/FIREARMS**"
56. Sure fire or any other bump fire device that increases the rate of fire is not allowed. *NEW ADDITION*

4. We need to improve the drainage for the pistol berms, level the berms to eliminate standing water, and dress up the berm slopes.
