BOARD MEETING MINUTES 12/8/2020

Meeting called to order at 7pm by President Tom Desmond

Present: Boyd, Desmond, Faingold, Kohler, Caraway, Baker, Dobbs, and Whitesides

IV. MEMBERS FORUM

Bob Daneker – NRA Action Pistol chairman, Bob asked the board for an exception to include berm 2 for the first stage of his monthly matches in 2021 which is almost 60 yards long. The NRA Action Pistol discipline currently has an exception in berm 6 when shooting out to 50 yards that they can shoot past the end of the berm between berms 5 & 6. By adding berm 2, they would not be shooting beyond the berm between berms 5 & 6. They would use berm 2 to shoot any 50-yard stages for 1-2 hours and then move back to berms 6 & 7. He would also like to add 4 dates (4/10, 5/22, 8/28 and 9/11) to the calendar for approved NRA matches which will run from 7:30am – 5:00pm on those dates. The board was concerned about how to prevent members from using the berms before the start time of the match on those days. Tom suggested getting a sign to prevent shooters from utilizing the berms on the approved match days. The caretaker, Richard can put out the sign the night before.

V. OLD BUSINESS

Financial Report— Treasurer, Loren Kohler - November revenues were \$17,847 and our expenses were \$23,566 leaving a net loss of (\$5,719). Our YTD revenue is \$224,670 and our YTD expenses are \$278,736 leaving a loss of (\$54,066). Account balances: Checking Account \$58,171; Payroll Account \$8,734 and Chase Savings Account \$192,970; Bank of the West Money market account \$152,136; Edward Jones CD – closed. Bank of the West CD \$205,981; Chase Bank CD \$201,742. Loren mentioned that the club has a new accountant working the books. Tom questioned the cost of snow removal with the new company, Land Tech as he thought it was higher than snow removal through Town and Country. Loren went through invoice payments to both companies and determined the cost difference is \$10.

Maintenance Update – 2nd VP of Maintenance, David Faingold – Arapahoe County Roads and Bridges added asphalt shoulder and placed numerous reflectors on the property at Gun Club Road & Alameda. Hopefully, this will deter additional damage to our fence there. Last year's budget for maintenance was \$45,000, as of November 2020 the amount spent has been \$34,000. David did not anticipate any large expenses in 2021. With Loren Kohler's help we have reviewed the expenses over the last four years which averaged around \$33,000. David would like the budget for 2021 to be \$35,000. Board approved \$35,000 for 2021 Maintenance Budget (see Motion below in New Business). There are just a couple of items that need to be addressed during 2021 in David's opinion, first is to repair the berms, and second is to clean up Coal Creek to maintain the flow of water. Manny Boyd asked if there were any endangered species that might be affected by the clean-up. David said he was not aware of any. David is looking into companies that have specialized equipment for cleaning waterways.

Review COVID-19 Restrictions – President, Tom Desmond – Tom wanted to thank PSAC chairman, Matt Hess for setting social distancing limits to 10 people per berm for his match. No additional COVID-19 restriction changes at this time.

Clubhouse Renovations Update – Board Member, Mel Caraway – Mel spoke to former board member, Dave Leiker regarding the renovation initiative that he was working on before his term was up with the board. Dave mentioned that the last contractor he spoke to said the club needed to hire a designer or architect to determine the needs of the clubhouse renovation first. Mel knows a few contractors that have mentioned they are backed up for months. He thinks the club should pursue getting a designer or architect in the meantime to determine the needs and then meet with a contractor. The board discussed asking if there are any members with design or architect experience that could possibly help the club. An announcement will be added to the newsletter next month.

Membership Renewal Update – Admin Assistant, Nicole Quiring – 675 renewals have been received and processed and 17 waiting for additional information. 28 members paid by credit card and their paperwork is still pending. 15 members not renewing. In-person payments will be accepted at the club on Saturday, December 12th from 9am – 12pm. Nicole asked if there was a way to add a link to the member's MyAGC page that includes a PDF of the renewal invoice so members can print their invoice from their My AGC page in the event it is misplaced. Tom thought it was a possibility and would look at it for next year. In addition, the Chase bank check scanner malfunctioned, and Chase was sending a new check scanner for deposits. Renewals must be postmarked no later than December 31, 2020.

David Faingold – David said now that the ATA match dates have been determined, that the club should look into signing up for PreSquad.com for shoots. Loren Kohler said he would look into it and get back to David.

Loren Kohler – The Chase Bank CD is coming due by December 20th. He has been looking at the CD interest rates which are at 5% and will continue to monitor the CD for the next 6 months.

Chris Baker – Chris mentioned to the board that they would need to discuss an increase in dues for 2022.

Tom Desmond – The trap staff asked if the club would be open Christmas weekend. He told them the club would be closed on Friday for Christmas but open Saturday and Sunday.

Attention AGC Members - COVID-19 Modified Restrictions

The board appreciates your patience during the State-wide Safer-at-home order with the following restrictions.

The following limitations, until lifted by the board, supersede the related published AGC rules:

- Remember – if you feel sick, stay home.
- The club is open to members and guests (*maximum of four guests at one time per the standard rules*). Please be sure to continue to follow all rules associated with “Guests” per the Aurora Gun Club Member Rules.
 - Member badges must continue to be visible at all times.
- The clubhouse, the education trailer and the bench rest trailer are now open, however they are limited to 10 persons in the building, “social distancing” must be maintained, no food or beverage preparation and a contact-tracing record is required if people are closer than 6 feet for more than 15 minutes. All persons 11 years and older are required to wear face masks when inside all club buildings.
- Trap:
 - Shooters must maintain 6 feet distance from each other at all times.
 - “Regular” weekend trap, Wednesday trap and clubhouse operations resumed in June
 - Coin operated use Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays.
 - Coins may be purchased in the clubhouse on Saturdays and Sundays
- Discipline shoots will be limited to 25 participants (or 25 per berm) with contact tracing.
- Spacing on flagged ranges must maintain 6 foot social distancing.
- Berm use is limited to 25 persons per berm and must maintain 6 foot social distancing.

***Please note: Monthly Board Meetings will have limited seating, due to the requirements for social distancing.

Aurora Gun Club 2021 .22 Rimfire Sporter CMP Match (non-sanctioned)

For 2021, Aurora Gun Club will be holding 60-round (+ 5 minute unlimited sighters) CMP .22 Rimfire Sporter Matches on SATURDAY, January 9, February 13, March 13, April 10, October 9, November 13, and December 11 (Second Saturday of the month). Sign-in starts at 09:00, shooting begins at 09:30 on the 100 yard rifle range. Match fees are \$5 for AGC Members and \$10 for non-members (this covers range fees and targets).

These matches are “non-sanctioned” (scores will not be reported to the CMP), but the match will be run in accordance with the CMP rules (we won’t be sticklers on the rifles used, but match standings will be based on those using rifles that conform to the CMP rules). If you have any questions about the rules, please go to www.odcmp.com/comm/rimfire.pdf.

Match consists of 5-minute unlimited sighting shots followed by 10 rounds prone slow and 2 rapid fire strings of 5 rounds in 25 seconds for semi-autos, 30 for bolt guns at 50 yds. Then repeat the sequence in seated position and Offhand. Offhand is at 25 yds. New shooters are welcome and encouraged.

Finally --- we will remain optimistic with regard to the weather. However, if the temperature is below 40 F or if there is or has been precipitation at 09:00 on the day of the match, the match will be cancelled.
