Election Committee/Resolution to Change Election Date: Passed out the resolution, made by the attorney, to move the election back to the September timeframe. He will put the motions on the table next month and would like the Board to review them.

Board of Directors, Randy Still:

Open Club on Holidays: Randy would like to take it off the table, and keep our neighbors happy.

VII NEW BUSINESS

1st Vice President, Terry Humbargar:

Safari Club Request: Terry has been approached by the Denver chapter for a membership donation. Terry would perform the orientation. The AGC has absorbed their current waiting list. There are 2 Safari Club members that are AGC members and each will donate \$25 to cover the \$50 new member orientation fee for the auction membership. *03.14.06.a Motion: That the AGC donate one (1) membership to Safari Club International Denver Chapter to be auctioned at their local banquet this April. The membership is not to be counted against the 1000*

member cap so the AGC will not suffer financially. The member purchasing this donation will be responsible for future years' dues. Seconded. Motion passes.

Board of Directors, Randy Still:

Newsletter: Disappointed that members aren't putting more items in the newsletter, and would like the Board to consider changing publication to 6 times a year, instead of 12 times a year to save expenses. Adams says we've tried every other month previously, and have had complaints. It is the only communication that the Board has with the membership and feels it is the price of doing business. Miller mentioned that it is important to get the minutes to the membership and knows of no other way to do it cheaper. Immel inquired about sending it a different class, however it would delay delivery. Visnak recommends pushing email deliveries would help. Huber points out that there other ways of saving money.

Board of Directors, Richard Immel:

Web Link: Richard has received a request from a local gun shop for us to put their link on their website and vice versa. He recommends that the gun shop should give a discount to the members. Humbargar said that our club does not do retail club advertising (motion 10.14.03.a). Dankowski pointed out that 800 receive newsletter via mail, and only 200 via email. Will give Board members a chance to consider, idea tabled, and will discuss it next month.

Board of Directors, Gary Ames:
