AGC Member, Dennis Ehrbar: Built a wood shooting table and bench from lumber he purchased at Lowe's. The table is stained red and has wheels on one side making it easy to move. It is on berm 1. He can build them for about \$33.00 a set. He will build 5 sets for the pistol berm ranges. All monies spent on materials will be reimbursed. The hours worked on the project will help lower next years membership fees.

PSAC Chairman, Matt Hess: Currently using pistol berms three through six on match days. Last month we had a huge turnout and did not finish until late afternoon. Matt asked to use berm seven for his PSAC matches in order to finish earlier. After much discussion the BOD felt they needed more time to think about this so it was tabled until next month.

AGC Member, Charlie Farah: A few weeks ago noticed parts of an electronic device that had apparently been used as a target on the 100 yard range. Note to all members: The only authorized targets are paper, steel, and clay birds.

Furnace - We were having problems with the furnace, so we replaced the switch, motor and control module. New filters were installed.

CRO's Corner

For the 2011-2012 certification period, the AGC now has 27 certified Range Officers (ROs). We also have over 50 ROs that were certified in 2010 giving them capability to act as an RO this year. I encourage all those members of the AGC that are RO certified to volunteer. ROs help keep the range operating safely and smoothly.

If any member or guest at the AGC is approached by an RO please treat them with courtesy and respect. I instruct all the ROs to treat all members and their guests in the same manner. Remember too that every person on the AGC property is an RO. By that I mean you have to conduct yourself in a safe manner and watch those around you for safe behavior. Stop any unsafe act immediately whether it is you or another person performing it! It is absolutely the responsibility of every member to read, know and follow all AGC rules as well as the 4 rules of gun safety. If a guest is brought to the range the member must instruct the guest as to the 4 basic gun safety rules, all rules of the club and the rules specific to the range being used. Another responsibility of every member is to be very familiar with the operation and safe handling of every firearm to be used. What this means is: The AGC member must instruct their guests on the operation and safe handling of their own firearms. Conversely, if a guest brings a firearm, have them show you their firearm/s so you are familiar with it/them as well.

Always ask questions of those with you and around you if you have any doubt of any kind. The use of firearms is inherently deadly therefore there is no such thing as a stupid question or too much information in their use, handling, storage or care.

The weather is warming up and those firearms will probably start coming out of their storage and into use. Please take the little extra time to clean, lubricate and check all firearms before they are brought to the range. Guns are machines and need maintenance please provide them with such on a regular basis. Remember every gun you use will be in your hands and or right next to your head while in use! That fact alone should make you want to be sure you are safe and the machine you are using is in good operating order. Have a safe spring and may many a bull's-eye come your way.
