## BOARD MEETING MINUTES 3/9/2021

Meeting called to order at 7pm by President Tom Desmond

### IV. MEMBERS FORUM

Manny Boyd – The 200-yd Military Match group would like approval to have a BBQ cookout at their April or May match, outside and possibly get someone to service the food. Tom asked Nicole to look at current COVID guidelines to see what is allowed.

Michael Quiring – Dave Leiker mentioned to Michael that the web cameras may not be updating as intended every 10 minutes, and members may not be able to see if trap stations are setup in the morning before coming out. Tom will look at the files to see what can be done to improve the performance of the web cameras. It was discussed that range officers will have trap equipment setup in the morning if weather permits.

### V. OLD BUSINESS

Financial Report — Treasurer, Loren Kohler - January revenues were \$15,509 and our expenses were \$16,829 leaving a net loss of (\$1,319). February's revenues of \$15,586 and expenses of \$28,084 with a net loss of (\$12,499). Our YTD revenue is \$31,096 and YTD expenses of \$44,913 leaving a YTD loss of (\$13,817). Account balances: January Checking Account \$55,781; Payroll Account \$7,521 and Chase Savings Account \$272,978; Bank of the West Money market account \$152,167; Bank of the West CD \$206,032; Chase Bank CD \$201,843. February's Checking Account \$52,919; Payroll \$8,509; Bank of the West Money Market \$152,216; Bank of the West CD \$206,059; Chase CD \$201,843. The biggest increases in February's expenses were Repairs & Maintenance \$7,820 and Utilities 2,825.

Maintenance Update – 2<sup>nd</sup> VP of Maintenance, David Faingold – David followed up from last month for recycling at the club. The cost is \$95/month with a dedicated bin and container we can place inside. The large bin is a 6-yards. Some discussion was had, and it was decided that the club will not take on the additional monthly charge at this time and will not sign-up for recycling. David also mentioned that Dave Leiker purchased a small Raspberry-PI device for the clubhouse that expands the use of the wireless and making the weather station operate more consistently without the use of the clubhouse PC. It has been working well.

Review COVID-19 Restrictions – President, Tom Desmond – No change to the club restrictions until reviewing pending state guidance.

Clubhouse Renovations Update – Board Members, Dietrich Whitesides/Mel Caraway – Mel, Michael and Dietrich met as a group to discuss different finishes for the clubhouse, and decided they need a budget amount so they know what can be done on the interior. Manny suggested \$150,000 would be a good place to start. Replacement of the ceiling is at the bottom of the list of items to redo. They did some research on flooring to get an idea of what it would be. To redo the floor with an epoxy finish it is an estimated \$9,000 - \$10,000. Nothing was officially decided or voted on at the time.

New Membership Update – Admin Assistant, Nicole Quiring – 32 new members have been fully processed and have attended an orientation, including 8 spouse members. 13 new members are still pending submission of paperwork. If Nicole does not hear back from them by Friday, we will move on and call the next 13 on the list. Another orientation date has been added – Saturday, April 24<sup>th</sup>.

Tom Desmond – Tom would like the board to consider hiring more trap personnel to ensure the club is fully covered as needed. There was some discussion about hiring seasonal trap personnel. Tom will run an ad.

## Attention AGC Members - COVID-19 Modified Restrictions

The board appreciates your patience during the State-wide Safer-at-home order with the following restrictions.

The following limitations, until lifted by the board, supersede the related published AGC rules:

- Remember – if you feel sick, stay home.
- The club is open to members and guests (*maximum of four guests at one time per the standard rules*). Please be sure to continue to follow all rules associated with “Guests” per the Aurora Gun Club Member Rules.
  - Member badges must continue to be visible at all times.
- The clubhouse, the education trailer and the bench rest trailer are now open, however they are limited to 10 persons in the building, “social distancing” must be maintained, no food or beverage preparation and a contact-tracing record is required if people are closer than 6 feet for more than 15 minutes. All persons 11 years and older are required to wear face masks when inside all club buildings.
- Trap:
  - Shooters must maintain 6 feet distance from each other at all times.
  - “Regular” weekend trap, Wednesday trap and clubhouse operations resumed in June
  - Coin operated use Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays.
  - Coins may be purchased in the clubhouse on Saturdays and Sundays
- Discipline shoots will be limited to 25 participants (or 25 per berm) with contact tracing.
- Spacing on flagged ranges must maintain 6 foot social distancing.
- Berm use is limited to 25 persons per berm and must maintain 6 foot social distancing.

\*\*\*Please note: Monthly Board Meetings will have limited seating, due to the requirements for social distancing.

### REMINDER TO ALL

For the safety of our members and staff, it is important that we continue to practice COVID-19 safety measures at the club.

Please be sure to keep a minimum 6-ft distance when conversing with members/staff inside the clubhouse and masks are still required.
