### **Minutes**

#### **BOARD MEETING MINUTES 4/13/2021**

Meeting called to order at 7pm by President Tom Desmond

Present: Boyd, Desmond, Faingold, Kohler, Caraway, Dobbs, Whitesides and Quiring

Excused Absence – Baker – Proxy goes to Tom Desmond.

#### I. CALL TO ORDER

**4.13.2021 b.** Motion to approve minutes from 3/9/2021 BOD meeting Motion seconded and passed

#### IV. MEMBERS FORUM

Mel Caraway - Mel introduced commercial contractor, David Dixon to speak about the clubhouse renovation. David provided many ideas for the renovation and would like to help define the scope of the work. He can provide the board with CAD drawings for the bathrooms and other designs at no charge. He briefly spoke about the reason for having two exits in commercial buildings, placing the restrooms back-to-back or possibly adding a drinking fountain outside the restrooms. Michael asked if there was anything structural in the building that needs to be addressed. David said no, moving the furnace and A/C unit would not be difficult to do. Mr. Dixon also said it would take approximately 6 weeks to complete the renovation. He will create a detailed schedule of work for the board to review.

#### V. OLD BUSINESS

<u>Financial Report</u> — Treasurer, Loren Kohler - March revenues were \$18,372 and our expenses were \$25,264 leaving a net loss of (\$6,892). Our YTD revenue is \$49,468 and our YTD expenses are \$70,177 leaving a loss of (\$20,709). Account balances: Checking Account \$51,705; Payroll Account \$8,369 and Chase Savings Account \$250,987; Bank of the West Money market account \$152,236; Edward Jones CD – closed. Bank of the West CD \$206,083; Chase Bank CD \$201,843.

<u>Maintenance Update</u> – 2<sup>nd</sup> VP of Maintenance, David Faingold – David has purchased supplies for the upcoming work party. He is going to get a couple truckloads of topsoil for erosion control in the berms. He explained that the club needs to increase and restore the berm along Gun Club Road and make it higher as well as the exterior on the 200-yd range. More trees will be delivered on Friday to replace those that have died. The new Trap field coin machine is operational and setup for doubles.

Review COVID-19 Restrictions – President, Tom Desmond – Arapahoe county will move to Level Green effective April 16, 2021 and will remain until mid-May. The clubhouse kitchen will reopen on Friday. The education trailer classroom is also back to full capacity with social 6' distancing. Tom asked Nicole to update the message on the AGC website homepage.

<u>Clubhouse Renovations Update</u> – Board Members, Dietrich Whitesides/Mel Caraway/Michael Quiring – Mel will be sending out the bids to the board as soon as he receives them all. He provided a recap on contractor, David Dixon's bid, and noted that David will only take a 1% markup on materials which will help the club.

The various quotes range from \$60,000 - \$104,000. Two of the quotes are a facelift and the others are a complete gut and rebuild project. Michael likes that David Dixon has preferred contractors that he will manage. We need to look at a monthly rental for a storage pod and replacing the existing tables and chairs.

New Membership Update – Admin Assistant, Nicole Quiring – 20 people signed up for the upcoming orientation on the 24<sup>th</sup>, waiting for paperwork from 4 newer people that were called, 3 need to sign up for orientation on the 24<sup>th</sup> and 2 new members cannot attend the orientation on the 24<sup>th</sup> so we will do another orientation June/July (date pending).

#### **VI. NEW BUSINESS**

<u>Incident Report</u> – President, Tom Desmond – No official reports. Tom announced that Chief Range Officer, Terry Humbargar has resigned but will continue working as an RO. The board will open up the Chief Range Officer position to all existing Range Officers to apply for if they are interested.

<u>2021 Board Elections</u> – Election Chairman, Dave Carriker – Dave mention to the board that it is time to start the election process. Please let him know if the existing board members up for election would like to run again. The deadline to declare candidacy for elections is August 31st at 7:00pm. The election will take place on October 3rd. Invitation will be sent to the candidates to attend the September board meeting.

<u>Work Party Update</u> - AGC 2nd VP, David Faingold – As mentioned above, David has ordered supplies for the work party and he would like to order individually boxed meals for lunch for the work party attendees per the updated COVID-19 restrictions.

Review May Calendar – Nicole Quiring reviewed the May calendar.

Dietrich Whitesides – The Approved NRA Action Pistol match for April went off well. They will be doing another match on May 8<sup>th</sup>. He also asked if members should be picking up lead from the berms? There was a brief discussion, and it was determined to be fine.

### Attention AGC Members - COVID-19 Modified Restrictions

The board appreciates your patience as we move forward with the following restrictions per the Arapahoe County Level Green: Protect Our Neighbors order effective April 16, 2021.
