**08.11.09a Motion to accept the minutes from the 07/14/2009 BOD meeting as published.** Motion seconded and passed.

**II PRESIDENTS REPORT**

Terry relayed an incident that happened in one of the pistol berms. Three shooters were in the berm shooting at separate targets at the same time. The problem was that the shooters were at different distances from the targets, which resulted that two of the shooters were beyond the firing line of the farthest shooter. The range officer, noting this action stopped the shooters, pointed out the problem and required the shooters to correct the action.

This is an instance of shooters not thinking through the appropriate shooting safety practices and can not continue. An accident can happen too easily.

An additional safety problem has been happening in the berms. The target bases have been moved away from the base of the berm so that the shooters can shoot from under the awning. This is a violation of Range Rule 40 and will not be permitted.

Both of these safety violations will be watched for and disciplinary action will be forthcoming if it is noted.

## CRO's Corner

Recently we have seen some folks placing targets and target stands in the middle of the 50 yard pistol berms so that they can shoot while under the shade of the newly installed shelters. I would like to remind everyone that rule #40 states: "All rounds fired must impact the end berm. Targets should be placed as close to the end berm as practical." The rule really needs no interpretation. Place your targets and target stands as close to the back berm as you possibly can. This rule holds true for virtually every range at the AGC. We want all our rounds impacting in the center of the berm after passing through the target. Please read the range rules and be familiar with the rules pertaining to the range you are using. We are really going to be firm on enforcement of range rules. If shooters are found with targets placed in the center of the 50yard berms they will be issued a major safety violation and will need to appear before the BOD. If you are found in violation of a range rule or are guilty of a major safety violation you will most likely no longer be a member of the AGC. Recently a group of shooters were found in the pistol berms arranged such that some of the shooters were forward of other shooters. While firing on any range, all shooters have to be in line (e.g. at the firing line) and all spectators have to be behind the shooters.

We now have 53 certified ROs. If you are an RO please consider working a few hours on the weekends. As always contact me with your intentions to work and also with the final hours you worked as an RO. I will keep the ledger for the end of year turn in and subsequent dues reduction. Once again, read the range rules and follow them. Please have a safe September.
