## AGC BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S MEETING MINUTES 8/9/2011

### I. CALL TO ORDER

### II. MINUTES

No corrections to the Minutes from BOD Meeting 7/12/2011.

**08.09.11.a Motion to accept the minutes from the 7/12/2011 BOD meeting as stated.  
Motion seconded and passed.**

### III. MEMBERS FORUM:

*AGC Member, Bob Smith:* After the IPSC match, the code to the backdoor is being left on the door. The clubhouse manager will check to make sure that the code posted on the backdoor has been removed.

*AGC Member, Bob Smith:* We need to make paper targets that look like signs and sell them because people are using our the signs in the berms as targets. Members caught shooting signs or AGC property will have their membership revoked.

*AGC Member, Bob Smith:* There are a lot of cigarette butt's being left on the range. All members are responsible for cleaning up after themselves, to include their cigarette butts.

*AGC Member, Den Ehrbar:* Will have 12 sets of benches and chairs already built and I will have 20 sets made by December. I have built stools for the silhouette range.

### V. BUSINESS

**President, Mark Harper:**

**Construction** - Qwest and Verizon have been on the on the property for the past three weeks. They may be here for 2 more weeks. Once they are done there should be no more closures to the 200 yard range until November.

**NRA Liason** - The NRA Liason's position was to attend meetings quarterly with information concerning the NRA. They have not attended any meetings. Do we need this position? The Liason receives no compensation and could be reinstated at a later time if necessary. After discussion, the Board decided to table this until the next meeting.

**CRO Position** - As of October 1st, CRO Martin Visnak is stepping down. We have a member willing to step up and take over, but is a Discipline Chairman. Should he be compensated for both positions? After discussion, the Board decided they needed more time to think about this and tabled it until the next meeting.

**1st VP, Chuck Steinman:**

**Range Officers** - I have made many phone calls to qualified Range Officers to schedule weekend RO coverage. I received very little to no response to my calls

**New Members** - We are one of the few gun clubs that doesn't require a new member to have a sponsor or reference to join our club. Could implementing this help bring up the caliber of our members. Would like everyone to consider implementing this before our membership drive.

**2nd VP, Dave Bonner:**

**Work Parties** - On July 21 & 29, we rebuilt the benches on the 100 yard line, painted the shed on the Archery Range, and relocated the patterning board to berm 1. We now have 36"x36" patterning paper available at the clubhouse or with our Caretaker Steve Dolan for \$.25 each or 5 for \$1.00.

**CRO** - Effectively immediately, I will be taking over this position of scheduling range officers for weekend duty until we have appointed a new CRO. Recently we have had no range officers on the range. I am in the process of setting up a two week schedule that will have range officers scheduled to work 4 hour shifts or 8 hour shifts if they want.

**Secretary, Dave Bonner:**

**AGC Member 0352 in violation of Rule 23** - While waiting for the work party to finish he was using a non functioning training gun in a manner that violated rule number 23. After being read rule 23, the member agreed that he was 100% wrong.

**Incident #2 - Shooting after dark.** Caretaker Steve Dolan caught member 0352 shooting after dark. Member was unsure when the exact time that he was allowed to shoot.

After board discussion it was decided to issue a warning. The violations will be put in the members file and noted on the membership log that any further violation of range rules will be immediate termination of membership.

**Treasurer, Bill Magaziner:**

For the month of June our income was \$17,192.00 and our expenses were \$18,624.00, leaving a negative net income of \$1,400.00. Our year to date income is \$10,329.00

**Board Member Debra Caldwell:** While shooting we need to be watchful for the farmer on the top of the hill. If you see the farmer or smoke from his tractor, a cease fire must be called immediately.

**Pistol Berm** - We need to fix the fence near the pistol berm where the septic system is because people are driving through the opening. Caretaker Steve Dolan will replace the missing fence to keep people from driving across the pistol berm.
