AGC Caretaker, Richard Parker - There were two reporters on AGC grounds today. One of our members had called the Denver Post and asked them to write a positive story. This member brought them as guests, but did not have them fill out the proper guest forms. The reporters did not take any pictures.

AGC Member, Brett Cooley - I and a guest were on pistol berm 3 when a range officer approached us. I felt he was very rude and had no people skills. I did not argue with him and complied with his requests. I later went to the clubhouse to find out who the range officer on duty was. There was no one signed in, so I went and found him and asked for his name. The board acknowledged Mr. Cooley's comments and agreed that Range Officer's should show proper respect to members. Next month the BOD will ask that the range officer be present to present his side of the incident.

VIII. NEW BUSINESS

Member Renewal Process - AGC Administrative Assistant, Candy Nonnemacher - The Membership Renewal Invoices and the updated Member Rules will be in the mail on October 30, 2012. I will be at the club on three dates to process membership. If I receive renewals without NRA verification, the invoice will be sent back to the member.

Changes to RO Policy - AGC 2nd VP, Dave Bonner - Currently our by-laws state that all members may only work off 50% of their membership dues. I would like to propose for 2013; dues for all members who work during work parties, as range officers and during the election be compensated for all of the hours they work up to the amount they owe in dues. My hope is that this will encourage more members to become range officer's and put in more hours as range officer and work parties. I would like to reevaluate this in August 2013 to see if the compensation change has made a difference in the participation.

I had the tractor serviced for a cost of \$898 and a quick disconnect hitch was installed on the tractor for \$380. I would like the BOD to consider approving the following dates for work parties in 2013: Saturday 4/20/2013, Saturday 5/18/2013, and Saturday 6/8/2013.

Financial Report for July and August - AGC Treasurer, Bill Magaziner - The total revenue for July 31, 2012 was income of \$18,009.70; with expenses of \$20,622.61; leaving a negative net income of \$2,612.91. The total revenue for August 31, 2012 was income of \$15,103.00; with expenses of \$9,487.00; leaving a positive net income of \$5,616.00. For the year we have a positive net income of \$9,424.00.
