III. PRESIDENTS REPORT:

I made a mistake last month by not taking the time to give thanks and credit to Terry Humbargar, Mike Miller and Randy Still for all they have done for the AGC. Unfortunately they had other commitments and were unable to attend the meeting tonight, but I want them to know that we are grateful for the time and dedication they have put into the AGC during their time as BOD.

IV. MEMBERS FORUM:

AGC Member, Pete Benoit:

1. How much money was made on the 2007 Lead Recovery on the Shotgun Range? Per Emmanuel Boyd the amount made was \$78,000.
2. Is it official the AGC is not relocating and do we have the resources to move? As of now, we are not moving, but this could change. We do not have the resources to move.
3. Per the BOD meeting minutes dated 8/8/2006 - the AGC was to allocate 5 CD's amounting to \$388,879.00 to the relocation fund. Was this done? Treasurer Paul Fann will research this, but it may take a while. The BOD will let you know what we find at a later date.

AGC Member, AJ Davis: Requests that AGC hire a knowledgeable full time Range Officer. Members using the range often make mistakes that could be dangerous. A full time Range Officer could eliminate a dangerous situation. BOD will discuss this at the next Board Meeting.

An AGC member asked if we are going to have our annual Christmas Potluck? After a brief discussion it was decided that December 18th at noon would work. AGC will provide meats, drinks and utensils. Request \$400.00 to pay for meats, drinks and utensils.

V. FINANCIAL REPORT

Treasurer's Report, Paul Fann and Mark Harper:

The BOD has received numerous phone calls concerning the AGC finances. The callers concerns were that we are on the verge of financial collapse, we have 4 - 5 million dollars in our bank accounts, and wanting to know if we have a secondary account set aside for relocation. The answer to all three questions are no.

What we do have are accounts at three different banks. Over the past few weeks we have been to each bank 2 - 3 times. At Mile High Bank we have two CD's, at Bank of the West we have one CD, and at Bellco Credit Union we have 2 CD's. The FDIC only insures funds up to \$250,000 so we opened an account with Chase and transferred the excess funds into a new CD. Our total cash as of November 5, 2010 is \$869,185.00.

CRO's Corner

The holidays are upon us and I would like to wish all the members, their families and their guests a most enjoyable and healthy holiday season. The ROs have forwarded me some questions they had asked of them by the membership. I would like to answer a couple of those questions here. One question was: "Is rapid fire allowed at the AGC?" The simple answer is, yes of course it is allowed! Just be safe and ensure that ALL rounds are impacting center berm after they pass through your target. Do not get all giddy and let the muzzle drift away from your target. Another question was regarding the placement of targets. Do not place any targets on the concrete filled tires placed in the berms. Those tires are used to hold the concrete which in turn holds a 2" x 4" supporting the targets. Most target frames made of wood, cardboard, very thin walled metal tubing or wire are allowed. Look at the frame and if you think there would be any possibility of a bullet not passing through the material then do NOT use that material to build the frame. Do not place targets on chairs, stools, benches or any furniture at the club. Treat every weapon as if it was ready to fire at all times, watch where the muzzle is pointing and obey the flags on flagged ranges. I really feel pretty much everyone, knows how to be safe we just get complacent and don't think about safety some times. Keep your attention sharp while at the range a lapse in attention could lead to an accident. Have a wonderful November, hopefully at least one or two hours of it will be spent shooting!
